Reporting to the Clinical Director, this position is responsible for providing consultation and direct clinical services for (2) 24-hour managed care homes (s) of youth leveled as 4 and 5 by Child and Family Services.

**Primary responsibilities of the position include:**

- Provide individualized assessments and treatment interventions for youth, including milieu group and activities
- Develop therapeutic relationship with youth
- Initiate and maintain effective strength based communication
- Facilitates various assessments prior to admission of a client, as well as on-going assessments as required
- Provide consultations regarding youth concerns such as FASD, attachment, and trauma issues
- Participate as a member of a multi-disciplinary team
- Collaborate with other disciplines in the delivery of services
- Assess risk and safety plan for / with vulnerable youth
- Facilitate training milieu staff
- Participates in peer group supervision
- Facilitate and maintain appropriate record-keeping
- Other duties as outlined on the job description

- Masters degree in Social Work, Psychology, Marriage and Family Therapy, or related field
- Four years direct clinical experience working with youth (experience working with sexually exploited youth and survivors of sexual abuse considered an asset)
- Knowledge and/or experience in Applied Behaviour Analysis (ABA) considered an asset
- Experience developing treatment plans
- Strength based approach to treatment of clients
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Knowledge of Trauma and Attachment Theory an asset
